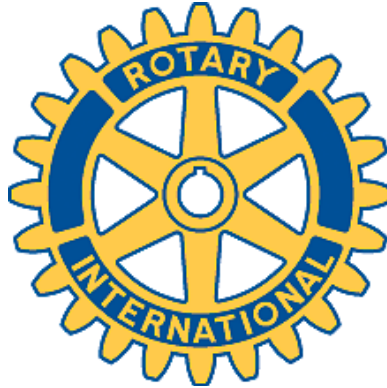

Club Rotarian of the Year Award 2010 - 2011

Each Club is requested to nominate a “**Rotarian of the Year**” to the District Governor by thirty (30) days prior to his official visit. The District Governor will publicly recognize the nominee during his presentation to your Club and provide the recipient with a special gift.

Criteria for the nominee are:

- Must be a current member of the Club.
- Must be in good standing and active with the Club.
- Must have demonstrated outstanding service as a Rotarian during the concluded Rotary year (2009 – 2010).
- Outstanding service is defined as:
 - Reflecting exceptional leadership for a major Club project or multiple projects
 - Demonstrating exceptional service in a key leadership role (project leader, etc.)
 - Contributing to the community in the name of the Club
- In the event no single member meets the above criteria, a team of Rotarians can be considered for the nomination. “Team” is defined as two or more Rotarians.
